

BENITA SUCHODREV – BIOGRAPHY

Benita Suchodrev is a photographer and artist based in Berlin. She was born in the former Soviet Union and immigrated to the United States at the age of fifteen where she received her BA degree in Liberal Arts with a focus on Art History, continuing to a MA in English Literature, graduating summa cum laude. The subjects of film and photography played a significant role in her curriculum and it was in the university darkroom where she developed and printed her first black and white images.

In 2008 Benita relocated to Berlin and began a prolific documentation of the cosmopolitan city's multi-faceted art scene, accepting commissions from private and corporate clients while continuing work on various photographic projects to be exhibited in solo and group shows nationally and internationally. Her work is a part of the Rafael Tous Foundation for Contemporary Art in Barcelona and private collections in Moscow, Berlin and New York.
